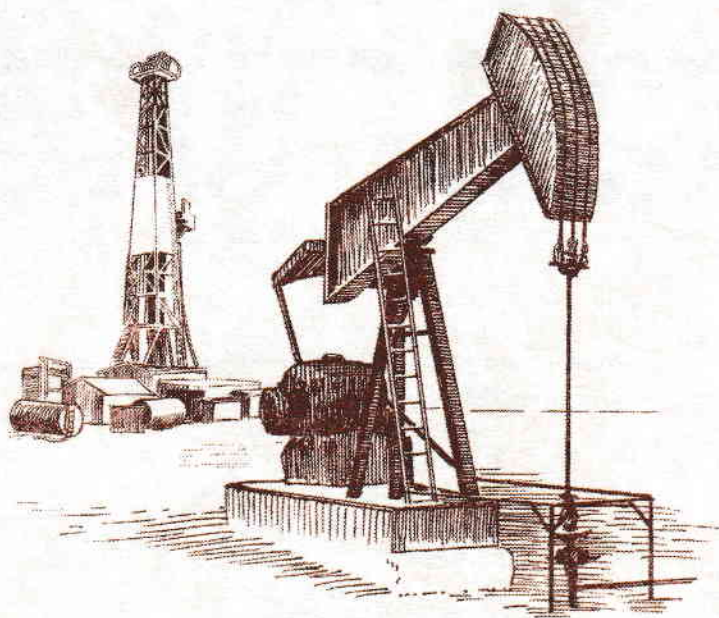






*Our prayers have all been answered
